<u>Eligibility</u>

To qualify to receive funds from this program, the following criteria must be met:

- □ The student's family must be congregation members in "good standing".
- □ The student must meet one or more of the following requirements:

- Student is enrolled and attend CBT religious school (chai) or an approved Hebrew High School
- Student is an active Board member of the local USY Chapter
- □ Student has completed, prior to program payment, 25 annual hours of equivalent, non-compensated activities for CBT of one or more of the following
 - B'nai Mitzvah tutoring (Cantor)
 - □ Toranim in the Religious School (School Director)
 - Assist in Junior Congregation (JC Facilitator)
 - Speak about your Israel experience during either a High Holiday or Shabbat service (Rabbi or Ritual Activities Chair)
 - Assist Jewish Federation with support activities (Federation Liaison)
 - □ Assist in coordination and execution of Israeli Programs as CBT
- □ The program must be a Rabbi approved Israeli Education Program. This will be evaluated as part of the application review process.
- Student must agree to speak about their experience at the following High Holiday services
